COMPLAINT AGAINST A JUDGE CJC-07-161

I went to the Justice Center at to file a forcible detainer action against one of his tenants. I was going to file the action in the Court. When I entered through the security area, I told the security guards that I had issues with Judge of the Court and that if he saw me, he would try to have me removed from the building. I proceeded to the line for the Court and waited to be helped. About ten minutes later, Judge came out from the clerk's area, saw me, and went to security and spoke to them.

A female sergeant came to me and told him that Judge told her that he had an injunction against harassment against me and ordered her to remove me from the building. I told her that the injunction had expired (See Attached Exhibit A) and that I was there to file papers in another court - not to harass Judge. She escorted me out of the building.

I physically met with and explained what happened. spoke to Judge and told him that if I had business in the court, a security guard would accompany me to conduct my business. Judge told that the proposed arrangement was unacceptable and he did not want me to step foot inside the building. will be glad to discuss this matter with the Commission.
