On [redacted] a motion was granted to release a \$39,000.00 Bond. I had complied with the courts as well as my first Public Defenders request. The Misconduct by both Judge [redacted] and Commissioner [redacted] began on [redacted] I called and spoke with [redacted] [redacted] I was told but not notified through the mail, that two warrants had been issued for my arrest. I then contacted my second Public Defender, who I could not reach but was able to talk to her supervisor who said she would find out about the warrants and address getting them quashed. [redacted] continued to practice misconduct starting again on [redacted] My belief that both Judge and Commissioner participated in misconduct together is reasoned by a complaint I made to the Special Investigation section at the Arizona Attorney Generals Office. I followed-up to further the complaint with the Criminal Division at the Attorney Generals Office. The complaint addresses a false arrest which Commissioner [redacted] said she had no record of, on [redacted] at a bond-forfeiture hearing that she continued. Judge [redacted] as well as Commissioner [redacted] continued hearings that could have been decided or resolved if misconduct by both Judge and Commissioner not happened. I am still incarcerated without my bond and a new bond that has me unworkable. The misconduct has violated my constitutional rights, Federal and State, as addressed in a postcard returned to me with this complaint.
