Dear Mr. Goddard:

On February, 28, 2006 I received the above referenced Complaint issued by the [Redacted] Sheriff's Dept. by Officer ID [Redacted]

I appeared as instructed on [Redacted] I pled guilty in front of the Judge because he indicated that I could take Traffic School. Then the clerk, [Redacted], handed me the Traffic Survival letter with Traffic School listings. This inexperienced clerk did not indicate on the letter (attached) the deadline I had to notify the Court about the traffic school date. Fortunately, I am a consciousness person and called the Court back immediately. Unfortunately, when I did call the traffic school, they informed me I was not qualified. When I looked at the bottom of the letter from the Court, it clearly states "*Speeding violations 25 mph or more over the posted limit are not eligible to attend traffic school.*" The judge and the clerk should have known that.

Then I received a Minute Entry and Order from the Court indicating I needed to appear again on [Redacted] [Redacted] for my Arraignment. Driving again all the way from [Redacted] approximately 85 miles roundtrip, the Arraignment is again postponed because the inexperienced clerk, [Redacted] did not notify the Officer in a proper manner. The Officer apparently could not show up and the Judge rescheduled the Arraignment again.

**If the Officer did not show up for the second Arraignment, this Complaint should be forfeited because of the State's failure to bring forward witnesses in a timely manner.**

If I would have not showed up throughout any of these appearances I would have had a warrant issued for my arrest and my license suspended. So because of the Officer's lack of appearance, this Complaint should be forefeited.

In any Court, if the Officer does not appear due to a citation, that is failure to appear on the Officer's part. Due to this fact, the third Arraignment should be cancelled and all charges dropped. Please respond in a timely manner as my next scheduled date is [Redacted]
