ORDER

The complainant alleged that a justice of the peace was rude, would not allow him to present his case, and upheld an unfair traffic fine. After analyzing the issues and listening to the CD recording of the hearing, the commission found no ethical misconduct on the part of the judge. The recording revealed that the judge did not display an improper demeanor and that the complainant's primary concern was the citation he received, which involves a legal issue outside the jurisdiction of the commission. Accordingly, the complaint is dismissed pursuant to Rules 16(a) and 23.
