ORDER

The complainant alleged that a superior court judge allowed his bailiff to prepare and assist jurors in deliberations, participated in a conference with only the prosecutor present, refused to take into consideration the complainant's mental health issues, and improperly denied his request for a mitigation hearing. After analyzing the allegations and judge's response, the commission found no evidence to support the allegations and dismissed the complaint pursuant to Rules 16(a) and 23.
