ORDER

The complainant alleged a justice of the peace yelled at her and was biased against her because of a prior complaint she filed against the judge.

The responsibility of the Commission on Judicial Conduct is to impartially determine if the judge engaged in conduct that violated the provisions of Article 6.1 of the Arizona Constitution or the Code of Judicial Conduct and, if so, to take appropriate disciplinary action. The purpose and authority of the commission is limited to this mission.

After review, the commission decided to dismiss this matter, finding no merit in the substance of the complaint, with a private advisory comment to the judge. The case is dismissed pursuant to Rules 16(b) and 23(a).

(I was the victim on the case). She also lend forward as to intimidate me when she told me I had nothing to do with the case. ~~The~~ I believe that she has been holding a ^{vendetta} ~~grudge~~ against me and my sons due to me filing a grievance on a previous case, with the Commission on Judicial Conduct before. She violated my son's freedom of speech by keeping him locked-up after he told her that he had two places to stay; plus she attempted to ^{make him} pay a \$700.00 cash bond to get out of jail (via television). ~~On~~ ^{third} incident was on April 11, 2012 @ 9:00 Am; Judge ignored me when I asked if she was going to give my son a rule 11 due to his mental illness, she also threw her hand up at me while I was attempting to explain further details of case. I also file for her to step down off the case due to conflict of interest & she, ~~in~~ ⁱⁿ a high pitch voice said that I could not file it, my son would have to file it; & "You don't have anything to do with this case." 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My son was also denied the right of attorney; one was not offered on his behalf. I was told by Judge Marez that she couldn't give him one & that he would have to be in jail to have a attorney represent him. My son was in jail from March 21, 2012 to March 28, 2012.
