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**ORDER**

The complainant alleged that a justice of the peace did not properly handle his criminal case.

The responsibility of the Commission on Judicial Conduct is to impartially determine if the judge engaged in conduct that violated the provisions of Article 6.1 of the Arizona Constitution or the Code of Judicial Conduct and, if so, to take appropriate disciplinary action. The purpose and authority of the commission is limited to this mission.

After reviewing the information provided by the complainant and the electronic court records in the case, the commission found no evidence of ethical misconduct and concluded that the judge did not violate the Code in this case. The commission does not have jurisdiction to review the legal sufficiency of the judge's rulings. Accordingly, the complaint is dismissed in its entirety pursuant to Rules 16(a) and 23.

denied and there was NEVER NO mention of it again, If it would  
have been brought up in court I could have had this diversion  
contract thrown out. Also At A hearing before the trial The  
Judge said that if some payments were made to the  
court she would Reevaluate if it would go to trial.  
There was NO mention of How much or how frequent,  
But some payments were made and there was NO  
mention of postponing the trial, If I would have known  
this I would have tried to have AN attorney there.  
I signed A paper At the Begining of this whole thing  
saying I would Represent the organization in court but  
Never to take the fall, the Judge allowed evidence that  
should not have been allowed, And allowed the  
Apache county Attorney's Office to violate Arizona's
