The Complainant alleged a municipal court judge failed to accommodate her disability.

The role of the Commission on Judicial Conduct is to impartially determine whether a judicial officer has engaged in conduct that violates the Arizona Code of Judicial Conduct or Article 6.1 of the Arizona Constitution. There must be clear and convincing evidence of such a violation in order for the Commission to take disciplinary action against a judicial officer.

The Commission reviewed all relevant available information and concluded there was not clear and convincing evidence of ethical misconduct in this matter. The complaint is therefore dismissed pursuant to Commission Rules 16(a) and 23(a).

I can wear hat minutes, then it becomes PAINFUL on my HEAD. I can withstand fluorescent lights for minutes, then migraine and seizure symptoms start.

SAID ON RECORD: "I DON'T CARE IF YOU BECOME ILL." also "stop taking the hat off." Violating 8th Amendment CRUEL & UNUSUAL Punishment RE: SEIZURE

I had requiring Ambulance to Emergency Room from Court. Violated ADA counts, RE HAT as MEDICAL Device, Fluorescent Lights as medical disability,

AND NO ASL Sign Language Interpreter. He believes the ASL was not necessary, but I need an ASL Interpreter for EVERY APPEARANCE.
