**ORDER**

August 11, 2021

The Complainant alleged a superior court judge engaged in ex parte communications, displayed favoritism by only enforcing orders against one side, and made legally erroneous rulings in a family law matter.

The role of the Commission on Judicial Conduct is to impartially determine whether a judicial officer has engaged in conduct that violates the Arizona Code of Judicial Conduct or Article 6.1 of the Arizona Constitution. There must be clear and convincing evidence of such a violation in order for the Commission to take disciplinary action against a judicial officer.

The Commission does not have jurisdiction to overturn, amend, or remand a judicial officer's legal rulings. The Commission reviewed all relevant available information and concluded there was not clear and convincing evidence of ethical misconduct in this matter. The complaint is therefore dismissed pursuant to Commission Rules 16(a) and 23(a).

\_\_\_\_\_ acted in contrast to testimony, and also refused to allow for more time and witnesses to be called, despite oral motion on \_\_\_\_\_
