ORDER

The Complainant alleged a municipal court judge improperly granted an ex parte protective order.

The role of the Commission on Judicial Conduct is to impartially determine whether a judicial officer has engaged in conduct that violates the Arizona Code of Judicial Conduct or Article 6.1 of the Arizona Constitution. There must be clear and convincing evidence of such a violation in order for the Commission to take disciplinary action against a judicial officer.

The Commission reviewed all relevant available information and concluded there was not clear and convincing evidence of ethical misconduct in this matter. The complaint is therefore dismissed pursuant to Commission Rules 16(a) and 23(a).

Commission member Barbara Brown did not participate in the consideration of this matter.

The Judge issued an order of protection against myself. I was arrested without a warrant by County Sheriff. They were told to arrest me no mater what I said. I am a disabled Vet that has been removed from the house I own with no due process. My second amendment rights have been violated. All based on hearsay. After filling a complaint against the Sheriff all charges have been dismissed with prejudice on request. This Judge made an at risk adult (disabled VET) homeless with ZERO evidence. I was also in Jail for weeks for no reason. When the police took me from my home the only item I got to keep was my cell phone. It was not possible for me to bail myself out. I also ended up in the VA crisis center because of this. I almost committed suicide after being told by law enforcement I was not allowed to defend myself in my own home as I was the one attacked.

- 1. no due process

- 4. Outside of jurisdiction. My address does not fall within This should have been started at county court. Also This evicted me and court does not handle evictions. That is stated here
