**ORDER**

December 20, 2024

The Complainant alleged a superior court commissioner used the wrong discovery in a criminal case.

The role of the Commission on Judicial Conduct is to impartially determine whether a judicial officer has engaged in conduct that violates the Arizona Code of Judicial Conduct or Article 6.1 of the Arizona Constitution. There must be clear and convincing evidence of such a violation in order for the Commission to take disciplinary action against a judicial officer.

The Commission reviewed all relevant available information and concluded there was not clear and convincing evidence of ethical misconduct in this matter. The complaint is therefore dismissed pursuant to Commission Rules 16(a) and 23(a).

Commission members Denise K. Aguilar, Colleen E. Concannon, Regina L. Nassen, and Delia R. Neal did not participate in the consideration of this matter.

In an email on [Redacted] with myself and Investigative Journalist, [Redacted] of [Redacted] Judge [Redacted] stated that their Investigator used, and requested the wrong discovery, which means [Redacted] used the wrong discovery, making several " prejudicial errors " in [Redacted] discovery/dr# [Redacted] which led to my unlawful conviction by considering inadmissible evidence, because the [Redacted] his crime of aggravated assault, which was given to me. Judge [Redacted] failed to consider that the [Redacted] only discovery in my name was dr# [Redacted] for resisting arrest, and it is not my fault that the [Redacted] prosecution provided the Judge with inadmissible evidence and I had no competent counsel, and now [Redacted] their Office states. a " [Redacted] " to myself and the Investigative Journalist. Just as with [Redacted] in [Redacted] my [Redacted] medical records and diagnosis were [Redacted] suppressed and my diagnosis was changed through the Rule 11 process, to an incorrect diagnosis, which [Redacted] is legal malpractice and medical malpractice and Judge [Redacted] played the biggest role in the [Redacted] Courtroom work group of [Redacted] the Prosecutor [Redacted] and the Judge, who did also deny my [Redacted] Constitutional Rights and I raised these issues with The Office Of The Honorable State Representative [Redacted] since I was denied those Constitutional Rights in [Redacted] and I have recently [Redacted] submitted a set-aside conviction which I am prepared to appeal to higher Courts

I have enclosed two money orders, after I requested my dr#/discovery of [Redacted] for resisting [Redacted] arrest, and the dr#/discovery of [Redacted] for [Redacted] and the charge of aggravated assault, [Redacted] which was wrongly given to me

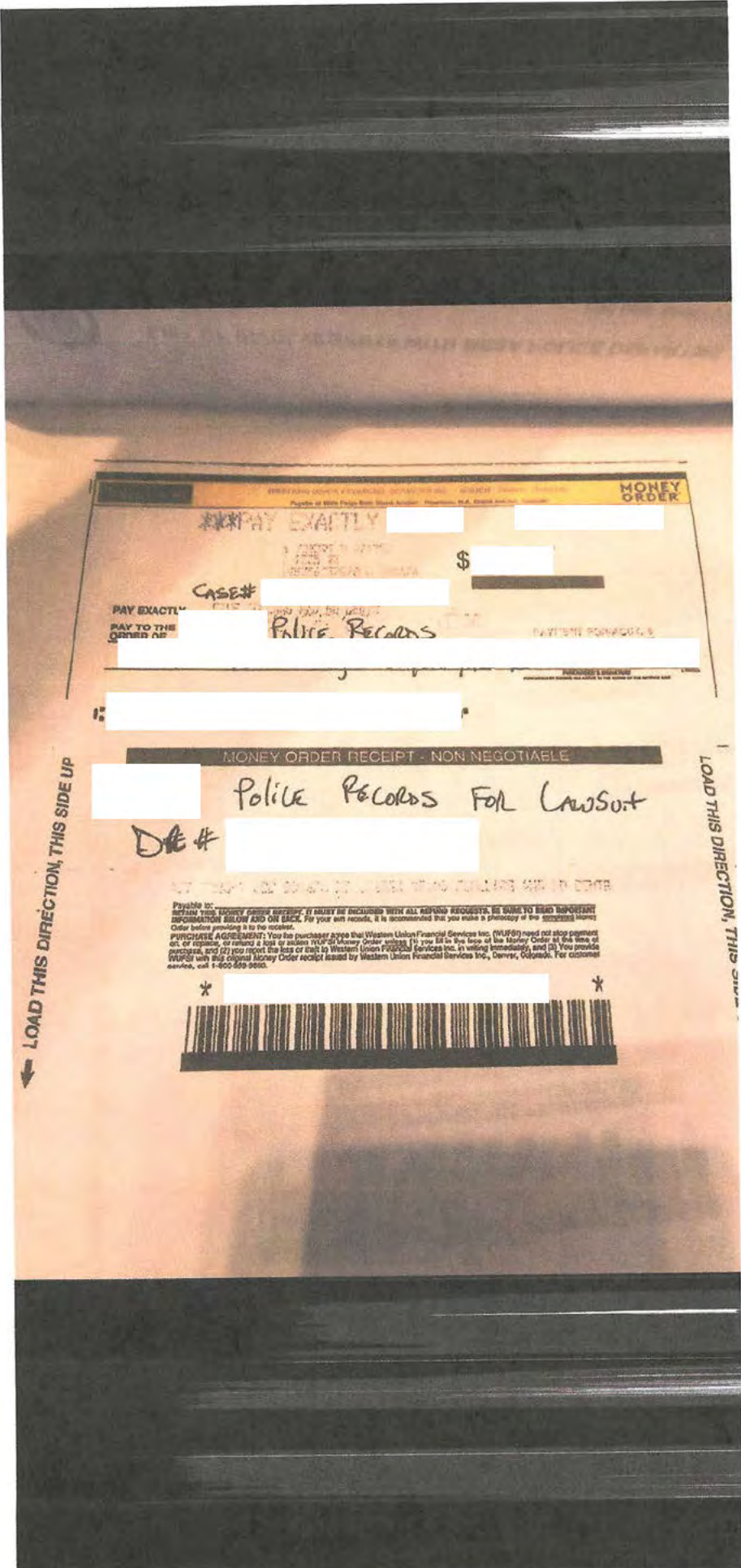
