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**ORDER**

January 24, 2025

The Complainant alleged a superior court commissioner was biased in a criminal case.

The role of the Commission on Judicial Conduct is to impartially determine whether a judicial officer has engaged in conduct that violates the Arizona Code of Judicial Conduct or Article 6.1 of the Arizona Constitution. There must be clear and convincing evidence of such a violation in order for the Commission to take disciplinary action against a judicial officer.

The Commission does not have jurisdiction to overturn, amend, or remand a judicial officer's legal rulings. The Commission reviewed all relevant available information and concluded there was not clear and convincing evidence of ethical misconduct in this matter. The complaint is therefore dismissed pursuant to Commission Rules 16(a) and 23(a).

Commission member Christopher P. Staring did not participate in the consideration of this matter.

I understand that you require your fom to be filled out to file a formal complaint. However, as the last time I provided my name in a complaint process I was harassed by government agent's at my home, I instead choose to voice my complaint anonymously.

Recently, County Court Commissioner found there was probable cause for arrest of for felony aggravated assault and resisting arrest charges stemming from an incident on .

There is BWC footage of this incident where 2 officers, and attacked, assaulted, punched, tased, and arrested .

If the video showed what the officers testified happened, attacking them, then there would be no issue.

Did even bother to watch the video of the incident?

However, since the BWC footage shows Officer drive into a parking lot, aggressively stop, then while giving verbal orders to " ", to a man, it then shows him grab, and push, and then punch and taze the man while yelling at him. There was no time for to respond, to communicate that he was physically unable to . Instead, we witness an out of control escalate violence against a man who had committed no crime. In fact, no violent felony had even been claimed.

The only accusation of criminal activity came from a criminal who was being trespassed from a local convenience store. There was no verification of an assault, only the words of a criminal trying to distract or redirect the attention of the officers.

Officer jumps in to hold down, while proceeds to punch the victim times in the face.

What was the supposed probable cause for the arrest that resisted?

What was the supposed probable cause for Felony assault on an officer?

Did officer [redacted] hurt his poor little hand while punching an innocent man [redacted] times?

Did officer [redacted] get bit on the arm while assaulting a man without RAS?

More importantly; does any of this negate the actual video evidence where a man is violently attacked after being wrongfully accused by a [redacted] criminal?

The fact that [redacted] finds probable cause while ignoring the actual facts of the case is absurd and I demand he be removed from the bench for his clear BIAS.

The fact this is even in a courtroom is disgusting and any prosecutor pursuing charges should be disbarred for their incompetence and bias.

We may be witnessing the next [redacted]. Local stations have started to report on this injustice. How long until the national news outlets descend to put Arizona's failed and biased judicial system on full display?
