The Complainant alleged a superior court judge made improper rulings in a family law case.

The role of the Commission on Judicial Conduct is to impartially determine whether a judicial officer has engaged in conduct that violates the Arizona Code of Judicial Conduct or Article 6.1 of the Arizona Constitution. There must be clear and convincing evidence of such a violation in order for the Commission to take disciplinary action against a judicial officer.

The Commission does not have jurisdiction to overturn, amend, or remand a judicial officer's legal rulings. The Commission reviewed all relevant available information and concluded there was not clear and convincing evidence of ethical misconduct in this matter. The complaint is therefore dismissed pursuant to Commission Rules 16(a) and 23(a).

When did decide to answer she only answered one bullet point acknowledging that I initiated the whole case and that was her answer for me challenging Jurisdiction. I never received a response, it just magically appeared in the docket as a Minute Entry. I have been under duress since day one. I informed her that I've attempted to make payments and she will not accept them. I have made several attempts to tender payment and all () were dishonored (). I made Postal Money orders out for Accord and Satisfaction for Payment in Full as instructions written on them. The Clearing House did cash the Money Order meaning this matter should have been resolved. Since Title IV-D does not allow any others in the courtroom during the hearing the only witness will be the recording of the court that may be available to hear. I personally went down to the Clerk of Court on to solve that matter and attempted to tender payment with the representative named and that was also not resolved. I do have my greencards showing that documents were received by the two officials in my complaint. She has ignored my request to validate the debt, to show me that I took out a loan in this matter. This has all been a matter of my rights be violated and deprived. This is all illegal and a violation of her oath of office. She has called my documents not legal documents, in which that is an opinion but not true facts.
